For Cypress Vineyards Merlot, the 2017 vintage was characterized by high winter rainfall, followed by a warm spring and moderate summer temperatures. Our passionate commitment to Cypress Vineyards red wines is to preserve and showcase the great cherry and currant fruit flavors resplendent in these grapes grown on the Central Coast.

WINEMAKER'S COMMENTS

The 2017 Cypress Vineyards Merlot offers distinct varietal aromas of black plum and cherry with subtle hints of toasty oak. The red fruit signature is reminiscent of a classic claret with its comfortable palate weight and bright finish. This wine makes a delicious pairing with grilled kabobs or barbecued short ribs. Enjoy in its youth, or cellar up to five years.
