Chardonnay is the most widely planted white wine grape in the world.

The Chardonnay grape is native to France, where it is the primary white variety of the Burgundy region.

French White Burgundies = Chardonnay.

Chardonnay is best grown in cool climates, like the Monterey Bay–influenced Arroyo Seco appellation where J. Lohr’s vineyards are located.

HOW J. LOHR ESTATES RIVERSTONE CHARDONNAY GOT ITS NAME

The ancient, alluvial soils of the Arroyo Seco in Monterey County contain large, smooth cobblestones. The stones store and radiate the day’s heat and improve drainage, allowing the Chardonnay vines to produce balanced, focus fruit.



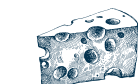
