Dijon 809, a distinctive Chardonnay cultivar also known as the “Musque” clone, is harvested in a single night in October from our cool-climate vineyards in Monterey’s Arroyo Seco. Traditional Burgundian cellar techniques make for an aromatic, complex Chardonnay.

Our Carol's Vineyard lies in northern St. Helena along the Napa River, at the foot of the Silverado Trail. In 2016, the Napa Valley growing season progressed slow and steady at our Carol's Vineyard from veraison to harvest the third week of September. Aged 20 months in French oak barrels from cooper Saury, 60% being new wood. Final blend composition: 92% Cabernet Sauvignon (clone 337) and 8% Petit Verdot.

The high fraction of Petit Verdot (22%) from the estate in this 2013 vintage library release has produced a wine expressing chocolate and distinct blue fruit aromas, alongside graphite and violets. A great example of a great Napa vintage displaying its exceptional ageability. Aged 17 months in French oak Bordeaux cooperage, 75% being new wood.
